August 2 – Skill and Well-Being Resource Fair (HISD, Wheatley High School):


Partnered with Houston Independent School District to host a resource fair that provided hygiene products, school supplies, household goods, and direct services to youth and families.

Over 130 community members attended the Harris Health Town Hall at the Flukinger Community Center in Precinct 2.


